



"FROM HOMELESS TO HOME" CAMPAIGN


Did you know that over the past four years in Central Ohio, there are 13% more single men, 58% more single women and 64% more families experiencing homelessness?


Those who are blessed with shelter are called to help those who are not.

PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:





- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.
