



PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:



- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a lowgluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

St. Michael offers online giving – a convenient and safe way to make a one-time or recurring contribution to support your parish. Getting started is easy, just visit <u>www.saintmichael-cd.</u> <u>org</u>, click the "donate" button at the top of the page which will bring you to our Online Giving link. Follow the simple instructions to set up a secure account.



Why use online giving?

• It's Safer – Your contribution is securely transferred directly from your account into the St. Michael bank account, which keeps your information secure. Your banking information is encrypted and not accessible to any users or administrators of the Online Giving system. You are the only one with access. When you manage your own account information, St. Michael does not have to handle any checks or worry about locking up documents containing your private account information.

• It's Convenient – To be considered an active member (required when requesting a school subsidy, letter to serve as godparents, or

other letters of good standing), you'll need to have an active contribution history. Online giving makes that easy because it's automatic. No more worry about forgetting your check or envelope.

- It Saves St. Michael Money Not only does online giving make it simple to contribute, it makes your gift go further and helps the Church to budget. Checks and cash are always welcome, but they do cost the Church money in processing fees and staff time. Since online giving is automatic, there are no fees involved. You can even give when on vacation or unable to attend Mass.
