





PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

 Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the clergy (if you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher, they'll be happy to assist you).



- Let the clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts) see photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say, "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond, "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.


PDHC DIAPER DRIVE



WHY DO WE SIT, STAND AND KNEEL DURING MASS?







We engage in different forms of posture at Mass to correspond with the various parts of Mass. For example, we sit during the readings and the homily because they are instructional, but stand during the proclamation of the Gospel, since it is about the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. We also stand during the prayer parts, whether the ones said by the priest alone, or by the congregation as a group. We kneel in Adoration and during the Consecration, when the bread and wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ, and before and after receiving Christ in Holy Communion.


