At that time, the Eucharist will be transferred back to the Adoration Chapel for Adoration as usual.

**MASS INTENTIONS:** If you are interested in having a Mass Intention in honor of a deceased loved one or a special intention in honor of someone for a special occasion, please email the Parish Office at [office@saintmichael-cd.org](mailto:office@saintmichael-cd.org), call the Parish Office at 614-885-7814, or stop by the Parish Office during office hours, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. The stipend per Mass is \$10.00 (cash or check).

## PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the clergy (if you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an usher, they'll be happy to assist you).
- Let the clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts) – see photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

## EMHC AND LECTOR TRAINING DATES

**Are you interested in becoming an Extraordinary Minister** at Mass or in bringing Communion to the sick or the homebound? Do you feel called to serve as Lector (reader) at Mass? If so, Praise God, we have great news...St. Michael is now offering quarterly training for those who are interested in being trained. The Diocese of Columbus has requested that all parishes offer training every two years for those who are active, or for those who would like to become active in ministry. The 2017 training dates are:

- **Tuesday, June 20th, from 7:45 p.m.-8:45 p.m.**
- **Tuesday, September 12th, from 7:45 p.m.-8:45 p.m.**
- **Friday, October 6th, from 7:45 p.m.-8:45 p.m.**

During these sessions, you will either be trained to Lector or serve as Extraordinary Minister as both training sessions will take place simultaneously. If you are interested in being trained for both, you will need to attend two different sessions. The training sessions will be led by Fr. Tim Lynch, Deacon Klaus Fricke and Deacon Bill Demidovich, who will prepare you to be certified for these ministries. **To sign up, please visit our website and complete the registration form.** (Registration and trainings are open to fully Initiated Catholics who are active and registered St. Michael parishioners in good standing.)

Repeat for five decades.

To conclude, pray three times:

"Holy God, holy mighty One,  
holy immortal One,  
have mercy on us and on the whole world."

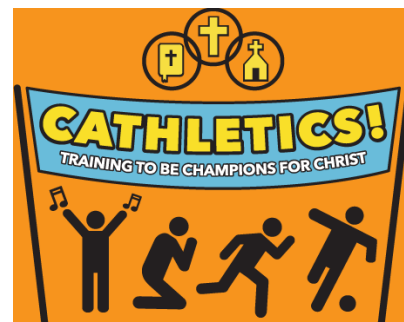

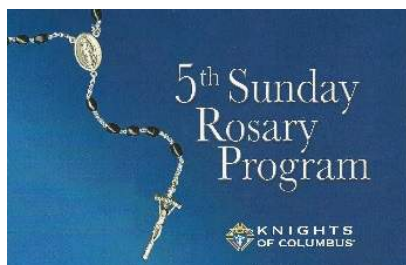
### HAVE YOU COMPLETED YOUR BUILDING FUND PLEDGE?
