PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

St Michael Preschool is accepting applications for 2017-2018 registration. We have a few part-time options available. Full-time has a wait list. Tuition and registration forms may be found on the Preschool website at <u>http://stmichael.cdeducation.org/enrollment/preschool/</u>.



Registration Process:

Registrations will be taken on a first-com, first-served basis with the parish families and those families with children already in the school taking precedence. When classes are full, waiting lists will be formed and vacancies will be filled with the following priorities:

- 1. A family already in the school.
- 2. Participating parish family members.
- 3. Any nonparticipating parish members.
- 4. Members from other parishes.
- 5. Non-Catholic families.

Each Preschool Class Registration form must be accompanied by the following items:

- A copy of the child's Birth Certificate.
- A copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate, if available.
- A copy of the child's Social Security Card.
- A copy of the child's Immunization Record.
- A \$100.00 nonrefundable check. \$50.00 of the registration fee will be applied towards the Preschool tuition cost and \$50.00 will go towards registration costs.

Registration will not be considered complete unless all the above information is provided at the time of registration.
