

The Days of Abstinence and Fasting during Lent and the Sacred Triduum are as follows:

Abstinence – Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days these faithful are not to eat meat.

Fasting – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted, but combined should not be more than one full meal.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed as usual on Fridays during Lent, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

Some ways to grow in your Catholic Faith this Lent. Three other options are suggested:

- 1) **Listen to St. Gabriel Radio AM 820.** Listen in your car or at home. You can even listen online with your computer. This is a great way to learn more about the Faith and put it into practice.
- 2) **It's not too late to join us for the remaining sessions of Bishop Barron's Pivotal Players program.** So far, we have learned about the lives of three Catholic giants, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Catherine of Sienna. Next up are St. John Henry Newman, G.K. Chesterton, and Michelangelo. Check the bulletin board in Marian Hall for dates and times.
- 3) Join us on Friday before the Stations of the Cross for the Knights of Columbus Fish Fry!



PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an usher, they'll be happy to assist you.
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts) – see photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

Every child deserves an education, but Haiti has virtually no public school system. Even a basic education requires a tuition payment or other financial contribution. The devastating earthquake in 2010 pushed even more children out of school and subsequent large-scale natural disasters have also disrupted children's education. Since then, the Society has been providing scholarships for Haitian students to return to school and start on a path to a brighter future. All scholarship students attend Catholic schools run by the Daughters of Charity, Vincentian Priests, or the Sisters of Mary. A \$200.00 donation supports tuition for one student for a full year, schoolbooks, uniforms, and at least one meal a day. FAITH FORMATION

WHAT IS ASH WEDNESDAY?

Every year, after you've attended the Ash Wednesday Mass, as you go about your day, undoubtedly someone says "Excuse me, but you have a little smudge on your forehead" How should you respond? One way is to see it as a great opportunity to evangelize, to share with someone about the most important person in your life: Jesus Christ.

So, what do you say when folks ask you about that smudge on your forehead?

The Traditional Response

Ashes are a sign of physical death, as in "ashes to ashes, dust to dust." We began as dust (a joyless and lifeless existence), and our bodies will return to dust until we are raised up by Christ. By receiving ashes and keeping them on, we publicly proclaim our intent to die to our worldly desires and live even more in Christ's image, which we focus on during the season of "rebirth" that is Lent (a Latin term for "Spring").

The Symbolic Response

God formed Adam out of the "dust" of the earth, which we read about in Genesis 2:7. In addition, Jesus healed the blind man with clay (earth and spit) in John 9:6. We mark ourselves with ashes as a "new beginning" at the onset of Lent, allowing the life of Jesus Christ to make us whole and new again.

The Personal Response


I'm a sinner. I don't always love God as strongly as I could or as directly as I should. Ash Wednesday reminds me that it is only through God that I have life; He gave it to me.

Ash Wednesday also begins my preparation for Holy Week and the Passion and Resurrection of my Lord, Jesus, without Whom I have no life here and no chance at eternal life in Heaven. This is just a great opportunity for me to become closer to God and to truly understand His sacrifice for me. God forgives. He loves. And He gives this sinner a second chance.
