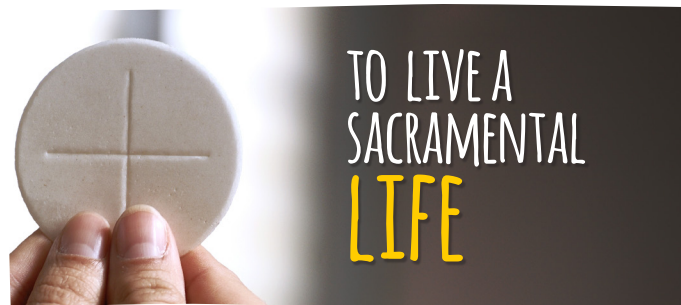

MILITARY ARCHDIOCESE COLLECTION:

Next weekend, our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS relies solely on private donors in support of its mission, "Serving those who serve," and its ministry to provide the same pastoral care and services to Catholics serving in the United States Armed Forces, enrolled in U.S. Military Academies, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs' Medical Centers, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders, and the families of these populations, as does any other Catholic Diocese. While the salaries and retirement of Catholic military chaplains are paid for by the U.S. Government, the AMS receives no funding from government or the military for its programs and services, including the Co-Sponsored Seminarian Program, which provides priests for home dioceses and for the military chaplaincy. 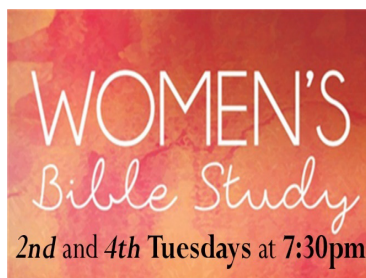

AROUND THE DIOCESE



Earlier this month, Hurricane Matthew devastated significant parts of the Southeast coast of the United States and some countries in the Caribbean, especially Haiti. There have been significant relief efforts undertaken by many government and social aid agencies, especially Catholic Charities and Catholic Relief Services, whose tireless work has brought comfort and relief to tens of thousands affected by this disaster.

While many have begun to assist, it is clear that the road to full recovery will be a long one, and additional support will be needed. In times of tragedy, we are reminded that the Church is always a primary source of healing and peace. However, as is so often the case, the Church itself in these regions is both a source of help and aid, as well as a victim. Many of the Church's structures have been damaged and their resources depleted, which makes it more difficult to fulfill the mission of providing aid, comfort, and the pastoral outreach to those in need.

With this in mind, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has requested, and Bishop Campbell has approved, a special collection from the Diocese of Columbus for those affected by Hurricane Matthew. These funds will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Relief Services and Catholic Charities USA, as they reach out to provide humanitarian aid in the Caribbean and the United States. This collection will be taken up here in the Diocese the weekend of October 29-30, 2016. Parishes are asked to remit funds to the Diocesan Finance Office in the usual manner for emergency collections
