





PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:





- Let the clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts) see photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ" and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

SVDP 6TH ANNUAL WINTER COAT GIVING TO WORTHINGTON STUDENTS AND FAMILIES



SVdP provided 331 winter coats to Worthington area students and families this year. Every student/family requesting a coat received a coat. In addition, 180 hoodies, 47 pair of boots and over 500 gloves, hats and scarves were given during the "Sponsor-A-Family" Sign-up Day.

We were also able to provide 45 coats to clothing room clients, 40 to SVdP downtown, 20 to SVdP Portsmouth, and 40 to the Griffin Center. A total of 476 warm winter coats was issued this year. During our October Coat Drive, we received 293 coats from Worthington Schools and 110 from St Michael Parishioners. Over the past year, an additional 150 coats were donated via our Clothing Room on the East side of St. Michael School. SVdP wishes to Thank You for your generosity and thoughtfulness in helping us be able again this year to provide many students and families a warm winter coat.


GIVING TREE PROGRAM

Year End Contribution Ideas for Your Consideration

A. <u>The Catholic Foundation Endowments supporting</u> <u>St. Michael Parish & School</u>

St. Michael Church Continuing Education for Religion Teachers Endowment Fund

This fund shall provide funding for the education of teachers of religion at St. Michael School and Parish.

St. Michael Athletic Assosication Endowment Fund

This fund shall provide for uniforms, equipment, and the repair and maintenance of the athletic facilities associated with St. Michael Parish and School in Worthington, Ohio.

St. Michael Athletic Assosication Scholarship Endowment Fund

AROUND THE PARISH

QUALIFYING CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS

Did you know that you may be able to make your Church contributions directly from your IRA and exclude this amount from your taxable income?

Sec. 408(d)(8) allows direct contribution to qualifying charities (churches included) to be **excluded** from income. Normally, when you contribute money to a charity, it's deducted (subject to limitations) from your income. If you are age 70 1/2 and have an IRA, you have (or soon will be) introduced to required minimum distributions (RMDs). After this age, the IRS mandates a specific minimum amount be distributed from your IRA each year. This distribution is ordinarily considered taxable income. For those not needing nor desiring this added income, it can cause major tax implications, especially if the balance in your IRA is sizeable. One way to avoid including part, or all, of this distribution in your taxable income is by making it a qualifying charitable distribution! By directing the custodian of your IRA to pay some or all (up to \$100,000) of your RMD to your church or other charity, you exclude this dollar amount from your taxable income. Here are the key provisions:

- You must be at least age 70 1/2.
- The check cannot be payable to you first, it must go directly to the charitable entity (this is easily arranged through your IRA custodian or financial advisor).
- You cannot direct more than \$100,000.00 per year per taxpayer, regardless of how many IRA accounts you have.
- It must go to a public charity as described in IRC Section 170(b)(1)(A).
- Only traditional (including rollover) IRAs are eligible. Other retirement accounts, including 401(K), are ineligible.
- Charity must cash the check before December 31st, so it's strongly suggested you begin this process no later than mid-December.

As with all tax matters, we highly recommend you discuss this with your tax advisor first.


