



First Sunday of Advent

Dear Parishioners,

Inserted in this bulletin are the Parish Operating Expense report for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year and the Projected Parish Operating Budget for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year. While there were some major expenses such as the concrete work done on the campus and repairs to the men's restroom in the undercroft, these expenses were offset by the Bishop's Annual Appeal refund, gifts to the parish in the form of bequests, and insurance reimbursement. Also, our Sunday and Holy Day offerings were up from the previous fiscal year (2015-16) by \$92,174.00. Our overall parish income was also up by \$130,633.00 from the previous fiscal year.

This year, we had a major project completed with the resurfacing of the parking lot at \$128,000.00. The cost will be offset by our Bishop's Annual Appeal refund (about \$33,000.00) as well as a sizeable bequest that we have received.

I want to thank each and every one of you for your generous support of the parish with your time, talent and treasure. I look forward to many more years of service to the St. Michael Parish family!

This coming Friday, December 8th, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Please check elsewhere in the bulletin for Mass Times!

Don't forget that our Advent Parish Penance Service is set for next Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m. Several priests from around the diocese will be available, so take advantage of this opportunity to prepare for the coming of the Lord.

May God bless each of you in the coming year!

AROUND THE PARISH

PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher, they'll be happy to assist you.)
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts).
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body
 of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen."
 Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.
