AROUND THE PARISH

PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts).
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

The SVdP Clothing Room on the East side of St. Michael School will be closed **Friday, December 22 through Tuesday, January 2, 2018**, during the Christmas and New Year's Holidays.

YEAR-END CONTRIBUTION IDEAS FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION

A. The Catholic Foundation Endowments Supporting St. Michael Parish and School

St. Michael Church Continuing Education for Religion Teachers Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide funding for the education of teachers of religion at St. Michael School and Parish.

St. Michael Athletic Association Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide for uniforms, equipment, and the repair and maintenance of the athletic facilities associated with St. Michael Parish and School in Worthington, Ohio.

St. Michael Athletic Assocation Scholarship Endowment Fund – This fund shall award scholarships annually to graduating eighth Graders, who participated in athletics at St. Michael School in Worthington, Ohio and who are attending a Catholic high school.

St. Michael Church Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide for the capital and operating needs of St. Michael Church, Worthington.

St. Michael Church Landscape Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide for the landscaping needs of the parish.

St. Michael Music Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide for the Music Ministry of St. Michael Parish, including, but not limited, to maintenance and enhancement of the church's pipe organ.

St. Michael Parish School Tuition Assistance Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide for not less than 85% of the distribution toward tuition assistance to deserving students attending St. Michael School. The remaining 15% of the distribution may be used to benefit teachers, programs, or other purposes directly related to the school.

St. Michael School Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide assistance in meeting the capital and operating needs of St. Michael School.

St. Michael School Scholarship Endowment Fund – This fund shall provide tuition assistance to deserving students attending St. Michael School, Worthington.

Grants and Distributions from The Catholic Foundation towards St. Michael in 2017 = \$44,660.75

Total Grants/Distributions from The Catholic Foundation Towards St. Michael = \$499,559.31



B. St. Michael Parish Faith Family and Future Building Campaign

In 2013, construction began and was completed on the New Parish Ministry Center which houses the Parish Offices, Pre-K, Adoration Chapel, and several Meeting Rooms.

Building Cost: \$1,913,122.00 Remaining Balance: \$446,003.23

C. Support to meet the operating expenses and other needs of the parish and school.

- Sunday and Holy Day Collections the through use of envelope system or Online Giving (follow link on Parish Website).
- The Bishop's Annual Appeal. (All monies over the goal set by the diocese comes back to the parish for our own use free of the 6% diocesan assessment on parish income.) This year, we received pledges in excess of \$33,000.00, which will assist in offsetting the costs of the completed parking lot resurfacing project.
