AROUND THE PARISH

PARISHIONERS NEEDING A LOW-GLUTEN HOST SHOULD FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS:

- Stop in the Sacristy 10-15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)
- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you will be needing a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will have the Host in a special pyx (a small container) attached to the main ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line as usual.

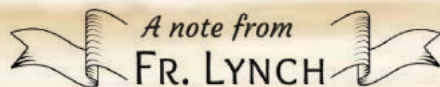

RESPECT LIFE

372 – Man and woman were made “for each other” – not that God left them half-made and incomplete: he created them to be a communion of persons, in which each can be

“helpmate” to the other, for they are equal as persons (“bone of my bones...”), and complementary as masculine and feminine. In marriage, God unites them in such a way that, by forming “one flesh,” 245 – they can transmit human life: “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.” 246 – By transmitting human life to their descendants, man and woman as spouses and parents cooperate in a unique way in the Creator’s work.

2202 – A man and a woman united in marriage, together with their children, form a family. This institution is prior to any recognition by public authority, which has an obligation to recognize it. It should be considered the normal reference point by which the different forms of family relationship are to be evaluated.

2203 – In creating man and woman, God instituted the human family and endowed it with its fundamental constitution. Its members are persons equal in dignity. For the common good of its members and of society, the family necessarily has manifold responsibilities, rights, and duties. Catholic Church.

Each Preschool Class registration application MUST be accompanied by a nonrefundable \$100.00 check (**no cash**). \$50.00 of the registration fee will be applied towards future preschool tuition and \$50.00 is applied to offset registration costs.

ADORATION SCHEDULE:

The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses.

The faithful are asked to attend Mass or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

The Chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.).

For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the Chapel door.

This is for the safety of the Adorers in the Chapel.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.
