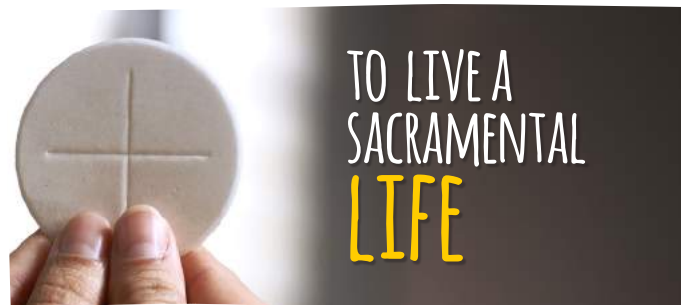

AROUND THE PARISH

DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)

- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once. you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.

THANK YOU

Heading into 2018, we want to thank every parishioner who donated in any way to St. Vincent de Paul's numerous activities in 2017.

We are truly blessed to have so many generous parishioners. Below are some examples of how your generosity helped our community this past year:

- 2,456 people in 978 families received food through our pantry because of your donations.
- Our Clothing Room helped 566 people in 130 families through your donations of clothes. In addition, 304 coats were collected along with hats and gloves to provide for our Sponsor-A-Family members, Clothing Room clients and others in need.
- 1,500 gifts were dropped off in the Giving Tree boxes this year and distributed to the St. Frances Center in McArthur, OH, Our Lady of Sorrows in Portsmouth, OH, and St. Lawrence Haven in Columbus to help support their Christmas programs.
- 332 children in Worthington found gifts under their Christmas trees, because you sponsored a family through our Sponsor-A-Family program.
- Your monetary contributions enabled us to buy cheese, bologna and bread to make 4,800 sandwiches to feed the homeless in Columbus.
- Toiletries and other needed items are purchased monthly with your monetary donations to help those in need at JOIN and Commons on Grant.
- 118 people in 44 families in our community have stayed warm and safe because your monetary donations allowed us to assist them with rent, utility bills, furniture assistance or other needs.

Again, thank you St. Michael parishioners! Without your outstanding level of support, we could not effectively help those in need. Please keep us in your prayers, so we have the strength to continue our work in 2018.

Any nonparticipating parish members. 4. Members from other parishes. 5. Non-Catholic families.

Each Preschool Class registration application MUST be accompanied by a nonrefundable \$100.00 check (**no cash please and we are unable to process credit card payments at this time**). \$50.00 of the registration fee will be applied towards future preschool tuition and \$50.00 is applied to offset registration costs.

ADORATION CHAPEL INFORMATION

ADORATION SCHEDULE:

When can I visit?

The Chapel is open 24/7. The only exception is that The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses. During those times, the faithful are asked to attend Mass, or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

How do I get in?

The Chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.) For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the Chapel door. This is for the safety of the adorers in the Chapel.

How do I register to receive an after-hours code?

1. Sign up online on the parish website at <https://www.saintmichael-cd.org/spiritual-life/eucharistic-adoration/>.

This is the quickest and most efficient way of registering and obtaining the access code.

This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings, due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.

2. Paper forms are still available in the Chapel for those without Internet access.

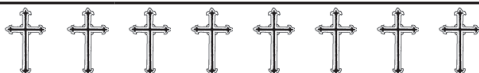
