



Ash Wednesday will be on February 14th. Please consult the bulletin for Mass times. We will be taking up a collection for the Diocesan J.O.I.N. (Joint Organization for Inner City Needs) office at all Ash Wednesday Masses.



The Days of Abstinence and Fasting during Lent and the Sacred Triduum are as follows:

Abstinence – Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days these faithful are not to eat meat.

Fasting – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted, but combined should not be more than one full meal.

Here are some things that will be happening at St. Michael Parish during Lent:

- Stations of the Cross will be prayed as usual on Fridays during Lent, beginning at 7:30 p.m. with Confessions following.
- There is a Lenten Parish Mission Scheduled for March 3rd-7th, with Fr. Joseph Tuscan, OFM Cap. (More information to come.)
- Parish Lenten Penance Service will take place during the Parish Mission on Tuesday, March 6th, at 7:00 p.m. (no 7:00 p.m. Mass that evening).
- The Knights of Columbus Fish Fry every Friday evening during Lent.

AROUND THE PARISH

DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)

- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.







ADORATION CHAPEL INFORMATION

ADORATION SCHEDULE:

When can I visit?

The Chapel is open 24/7. The only exception is that The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses. During those times, the faithful are asked to attend Mass, or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

How do I get in?

The chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.). For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the Chapel door. This is for the safety of the Adorers in the Chapel.

How do I register to receive an after-hours code?

1. Sign up online on the parish website at https://www.saintmichael-cd.org/spiritual-life/eucharistic-adoration/. This is the quickest and most efficient way of registering and obtaining the access code. This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings, due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.

2. Paper forms are still available in the Chapel for those without Internet access.
