



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, at the end of all Masses, we will have our annual Missionary Co-operative



Appeal in conjunction with the Diocesan Missions Office. Dr. Amine Kidane, a member of St. Michael Parish, will make an appeal on behalf of The Catholic Eparchy of Keren in Eritrea (East Africa).

Eritrea, located on the Horn of Africa, has a population of about 3.5 million. The population of the area covered by the Diocese of Keren is 450,000, of which about 12% are Catholic and 80% are Muslim.

The Diocese of Keren is located in an arid, semi-desert, rocky, rugged mountainous region and is ravaged with frequent droughts. Often, even finding drinking water is a challenge. As our people continue to struggle with difficulties that hamper development at every turn, the Catholic Church is a beacon of hope that provides pastoral care, runs clinics, feeds malnourished children, cares for expecting mothers, orphans, those with autism, down syndrome and promotes peace and reconciliation.

The Diocese of Keren is blessed with many vocations. For the Diocese of Keren to continue its mission of spreading the Gospel, we humbly ask for prayers and generous financial support. To this end, there will be a second collection taken up after Dr. Kidane's presentation, which will be after the Communion Rite at all Masses. To keep this collection separate from the general collection, please place your donations for this appeal in the second collection basket only. Make checks out to St. Michael Parish. All funds collected will then be directed to The Catholic Eparchy of Keren from the parish. Thank you for your generosity.

## AROUND THE PARISH

#### DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy.

(If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)

- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.

## ADORATION CHAPEL INFORMATION

#### **ADORATION SCHEDULE:**

When can I visit? The Chapel is open 24/7. The only exception is that The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses. During those times, the faithful are asked to attend Mass or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

How do I get in? The chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.). For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the chapel door. This is for the safety of the Adorers in the Chapel.

#### How do I register to receive an after-hours code?

- 1. Sign up online on the parish website at https://www.saintmichael-cd.org/spiritual-life/eucharistic-adoration/. This is the quickest and most efficient way of registering and obtaining the access code. This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.
- 2. Paper forms are still available in the chapel for those without Internet access. Fill one out and slip it under the parish window at any time. Questions? Email adoration@saintmichael-cd.org.

When entering the Chapel, everyone (scheduled Adorers, substitutes, visitors, drop-ins, and guests) are asked to sign in at the podium in the Chapel corner This eliminates any confusion regarding who is or is not providing continuous coverage.


