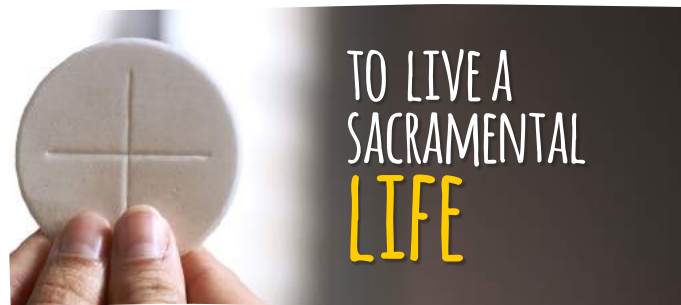



Would you like to offer a Mass for a deceased loved one or for the Special Intention of someone special to you? It’s easy – just email us at office@saintmichael-cd.org, and put “Mass Intentions” in the subject line. Let us know the full name of the person the Mass is for, whether they are living or deceased and give three dates (per Mass intention) you would like for us to check the availability of and we will assign the first one available (or the one nearest to the date you requested). Families may request up to four Sunday Masses per year. If you need to schedule one or two Masses, feel free to stop by the Parish Office Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. The stipend for each Mass is \$10.00, payable to St. Michael Catholic Church, which you can place in any weekend offering basket in a plain envelope marked “Mass Intentions.”

DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy.
(If you’re not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They’ll be happy to assist you.)



- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the “Joseph Side.”
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say “The Body of Christ,” and then will place it in your palm once you respond “Amen.” Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.

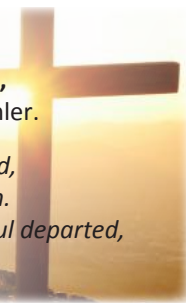

DEAR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Are you interested in deepening your faith this summer as you break from school? **EXPLORE** is one of 92 programs being held around the country at different universities. **EXPLORE** provides a residential experience at Ohio Wesleyan University with two days of classroom theology, two days of service and two days of wilderness experiences, starting June 10th through June 17th.

The cost is \$240.00 for the entire program and **EXPLORE** has scholarship opportunities available.

EXPLORE will have two religion professors from the university, Methodist and Evangelical, as well as Father Thomas Blau, O.P., from St. Patrick Church, facilitating the classroom sections. Sr. Mary Magdalene from the Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist will also be in residence for the entire week.

High school students will be interacting with college student leaders, who are from various faith backgrounds including Catholic, and an advisory team with years of experience in youth ministry. All staff are diocesan and PGC-trained and certified, regardless of denomination.

EXPLORE is looking for high school students who are willing and wanting to engage in that next step.

This would be a rich experience to learn more about Catholicism, but also have the opportunity to have ecumenical conversations, learn the differences and similarities with other denominations and seek out fellowship with each other. This is the reality of the college experience. **EXPLORE** offers a safe space to learn more about ecumenism as well as how to encounter and navigate diversity in the future. The goal of **EXPLORE** is to strengthen faith foundation and encourage further study. 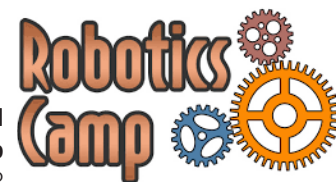


ST. CHARLES ROBOTICS TEAM OFFERING FIVE TECHNOLOGY/ROBOTICS CLASSES

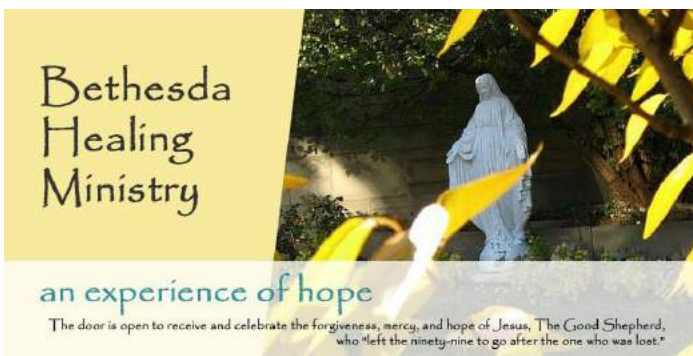

ADORATION CHAPEL INFORMATION

ADORATION SCHEDULE:

When can I visit? The Chapel is open 24/7. The only exception is that The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses. During those times, the faithful are asked to attend Mass or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

How do I get in? The chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.). For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the chapel door. This is for the safety of the Adorers in the Chapel.

How do I register to receive an after-hours code?

1. Sign up online on the parish website at <https://www.saintmichael-cd.org/spiritual-life/eucharistic-adoration/>. This is the quickest and most efficient way of registering and obtaining the access code. This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.

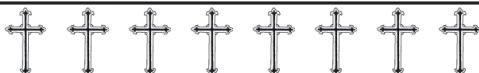
