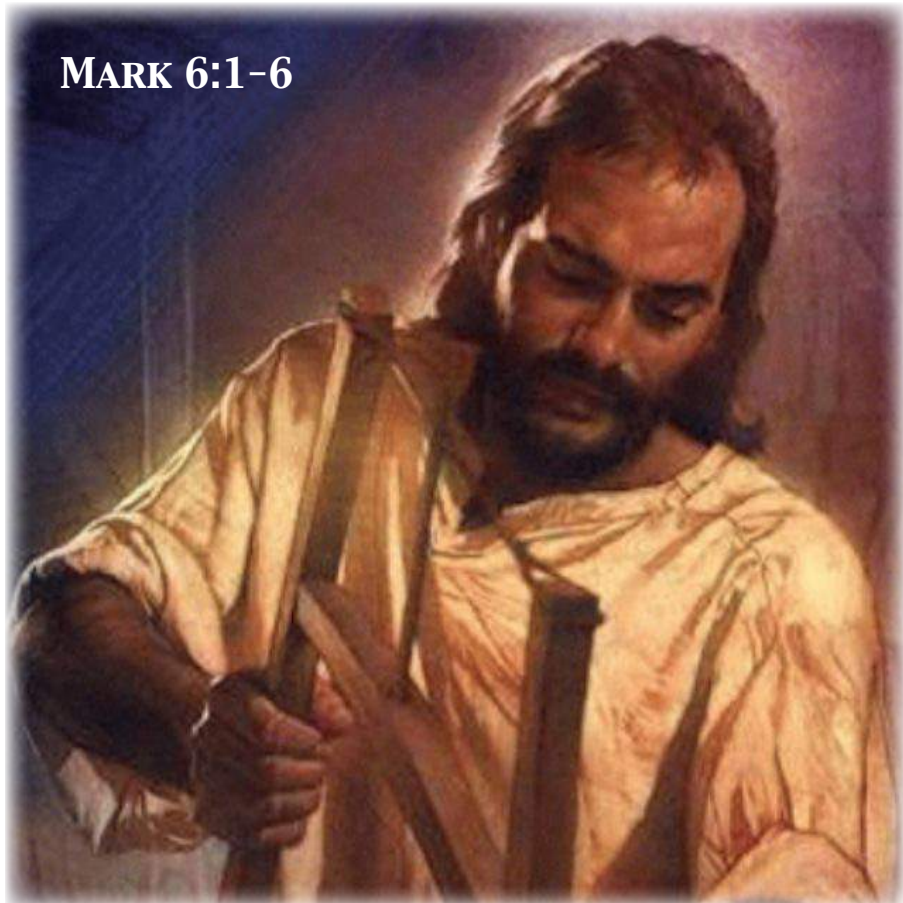

### MASS INTENTION REQUESTS – WOULD YOU LIKE TO HAVE A MASS OFFERED FOR SOMEONE?

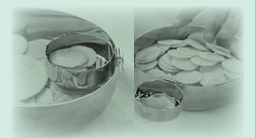
Would you like to offer a Mass for a deceased loved one or for the Special Intention of someone special to you? It's easy – just email us at [office@saintmichael-cd.org](mailto:office@saintmichael-cd.org), and put "Mass Intentions" in the subject line. Let us know the full name of the person the Mass is for, whether they are living or deceased, and give three dates (per Mass intention) you would like for us to check the availability of and we will assign the first one available (or the one nearest to the date you requested). Families may request up to four Sunday Masses per year. If you need to schedule one or two Masses, feel free to stop by the Parish Office Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. The stipend for each Mass is \$10.00, payable to St. Michael Catholic Church, which you can place in any weekend offering basket in a plain envelope marked "Mass Intentions."

### DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy.  
(If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)



- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.

### UPDATE ON PREKINDERGARTEN

We are pleased to announce that we will be adding a 2nd full-time PreKindergarten Classroom for the 2018-2019 school year. We are very excited about this addition as a response to a consistent need from the community for quality full-time PreKindergarten instruction. Our program offers Phonics/Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, Religion, Art, and Music, with a balance between hands-on instruction, whole group, small group, and centers. Our day is balanced between Kindergarten-readiness academics, using whole-group instruction and centers where the children play. All the children are four and PreKindergarten age. We use Creative Curriculum, which is a theme-based curriculum and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, which is a hands-on, Montessori-based approach to Catholic education.

# ADORATION CHAPEL INFORMATION

## ADORATION SCHEDULE:

**When can I visit?** The Chapel is open 24/7. The only exception is that The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed during Masses, including weekday Masses. During those times, the faithful are asked to attend Mass or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle in church.

**How do I get in?** The chapel is unlocked whenever the Parish Office is open (Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.). For access outside of those hours, registration is required to obtain the access code to the front door and the chapel door. This is for the safety of the Adorers in the Chapel.

### How do I register to receive an after-hours code?

1. Sign up online on the parish website at <https://www.saintmichael-cd.org/spiritual-life/eucharistic-adoration/>. This is the quickest and most efficient way of registering and obtaining the access code. This will also allow you to keep updated via email on news about the Chapel closings due to weather, holy days, etc., and when the code changes periodically.
2. Paper forms are still available in the chapel for those without Internet access. Fill one out and slip it under the parish window at any time. Questions? Email [adoration@saintmichael-cd.org](mailto:adoration@saintmichael-cd.org).

**When entering the Chapel, everyone (scheduled Adorers, substitutes, visitors, drop-ins, and guests) is asked to sign in at the podium in the Chapel corner. This eliminates any confusion regarding who is or is not providing continuous coverage.**

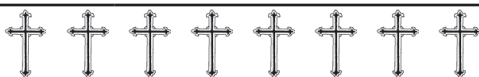
