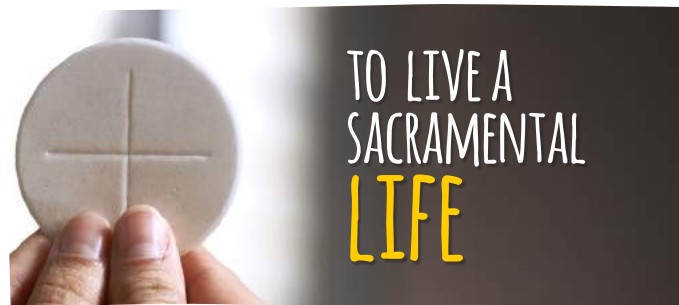

MASS INTENTION REQUESTS – WOULD YOU LIKE TO HAVE A MASS OFFERED FOR SOMEONE?

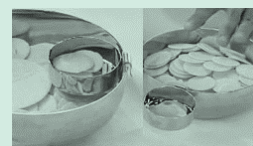


Would you like to offer a Mass for a deceased loved one or for the Special Intention of someone special to you? It's easy. Just email us at office@saintmichael-cd.org and put "Mass Intentions" in the subject line. Let us know the full name of the person the Mass is for (whether they are living or deceased), and give three dates (per Mass Intention) of dates you would like for us to check the availability of, and we will assign the first one available (or the one nearest to the date you requested). Families may request up to four Sunday Masses per year. **Please note that we only have a few 6:30 a.m. Masses left for 2018 and are scheduling for 2019 Masses now.** The stipend for each Mass is \$10.00, payable to St. Michael Catholic Church, which you can place in any weekend offering basket in a plain envelope marked "Mass Intentions."

DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy.
(If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)

- Let the Clergy member (Priest or Deacon) know that you need a low-gluten Host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten Host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say, "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.

PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) NOW ACCEPTING REGISTRATIONS FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

The Parish School of Religion (PSR) Program is for the children of our parish, Grades K-5, who desire to be formed and equipped in living the Catholic Faith and be strengthened through preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion.

The **Summit** program is for students in Grades 6-8, including Confirmation. Students receive instruction based on the Diocesan Religion Course of Study and are catechized in an age-appropriate way by volunteer teachers.

Information and Registration materials are found at www.saintmichael-cd.org/evangelization/psr. You will need to register for SchoolSpeak first. The directions for doing so are found on the parish website.

We seek to be a welcoming parish and strive to work with the families to meet the needs of every student enrolled. For families with children who are older (8 and up) who have not yet received religious instruction, classes will be organized according to the needs of the students each year, with instruction on the fundamentals of our faith and specific sacramental preparation. These classes – Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC) – begin in the fall and are offered as needed. Parents interested in enrolling their children in RCIC Classes should speak to the Director of Religious Education directly by calling **614-888-5384**, or emailing Katie Roden, Director of Religious Education, at kroden@saintmichael-cd.org.

- Be an active, registered member of St. Michael (*if you need to officially register, on the website under "About Us select" Welcome New Members*).
- Be a practicing Catholic (attend weekly Sunday Mass, have all your Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Holy First Communion, Confirmation).
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- If married, your marriage must be recognized by the Catholic Church.
- Be available to serve at least once a month.
