

Let us know the full name of the person the Mass is for, whether they are living or deceased and give 3 dates (per Mass intention) of dates you would like for us to check the availability of and we will assign the first one available (or the one nearest to the date you requested. Families may request up to four Sunday Masses per year). If you need to schedule just one to two Masses, feel free to stop by the Parish Office, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. The stipend for each Mass is \$10.00 payable to St. Michael Catholic Church, which you can place in any weekend offering basket in a plain envelope marked "Mass Intentions."

### DO YOU NEED A LOW-GLUTEN HOST FOR COMMUNION?

Stop in the Sacristy at least 15 minutes before Mass and find a member of the Clergy. (If you're not sure where the Sacristy is, please ask an Usher. They'll be happy to assist you.)

- Let the Clergy member (priest or deacon) know that you need a low-gluten host.
- Find a seat on the right side of the church (when facing the Altar), affectionately known as the "Joseph Side."
- Follow the Communion line as you usually would.
- Look for Clergy or Extraordinary Minister who has a pyx (small cup) attached to their ciborium (the container holding the Hosts). See photo.
- When you approach the Minister, just indicate by pointing to the pyx that contains the low-gluten host.
- The Clergy or Extraordinary Minister will hold the Host up and say "The Body of Christ," and then will place it in your palm once you respond "Amen." Immediately consume the Host and follow the Communion line, as usual.



### TO CELEBRATE THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF HUMANAE VITAE THE RESPECT LIFE CORNER WILL CONTAIN EXCERPTS FROM THE DOCUMENT.



The full document can be accessed through the Vatican's website. Interpreting the Moral Law – 4. This kind of question requires from the teaching authority of the Church a new and deeper reflection on the principles of the moral teaching on marriage - a teaching which is based on the natural law as illuminated and enriched by divine Revelation. No member of the faithful could possibly deny that the Church is competent in her magisterium to interpret the natural moral law. It is in fact indisputable, as Our predecessors have many times declared, (I) that Jesus Christ, when He communicated His divine power to Peter and the other Apostles and sent them to teach all nations His commandments, (2) constituted them as the authentic guardians and interpreters of the whole moral law, not only, that is, of the law of the Gospel but also of the natural law. For the natural law, too, declares the will of God, and its faithful observance is necessary for men's eternal salvation. (3) In carrying out this mandate, the Church has always issued appropriate documents on the nature of marriage, the correct use of conjugal rights, and the duties of spouses.
