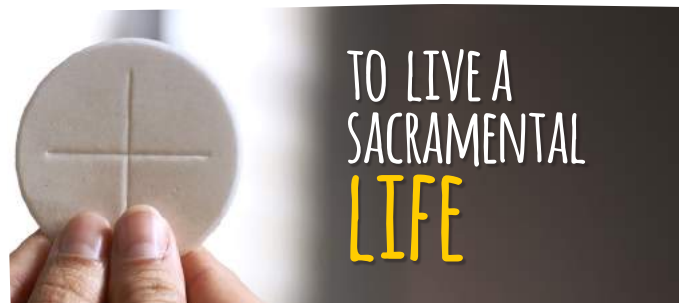

- Saturday, December 15th, at 9:00 a.m., we will begin the first phase of decorating by hanging lights outside and setting up the crèches inside and outside the church.

- Masses for Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day will be published in the bulletin or can be found on the parish website.
