SACRAMENT OF THE SICK





- Saturday, December 8th (Friday evening, December 7th) is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, which is a Holy Day of Obligation. Check the bulletin or website for Mass Times. Please note that the 4:00 p.m. Saturday evening Mass is for the 2nd Sunday of Advent and does not count for the fulfillment of the Obligation Day observance.
- Sunday, December 9th, our Parish Penance Service will begin at 7:00 p.m. Several priests from around the area will be on hand to hear Confessions that evening.
- Saturday, December 15th, at 9:00 a.m., we will begin the first phase of decorating by hanging lights outside and setting up the crèches inside and outside the church.
- Saturday. December 22nd, we will put the finishing touches on the Christmas decorations inside and outside. Remember, the more people that help, the faster it will go. Make this your family tradition every year!


