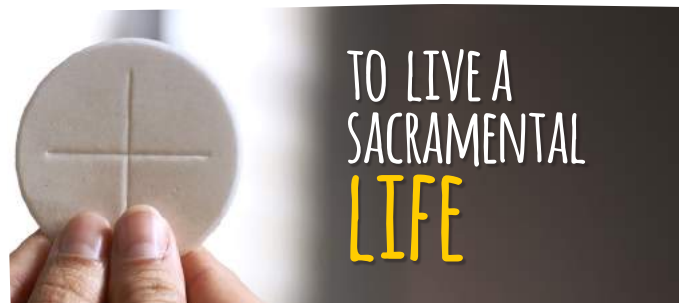

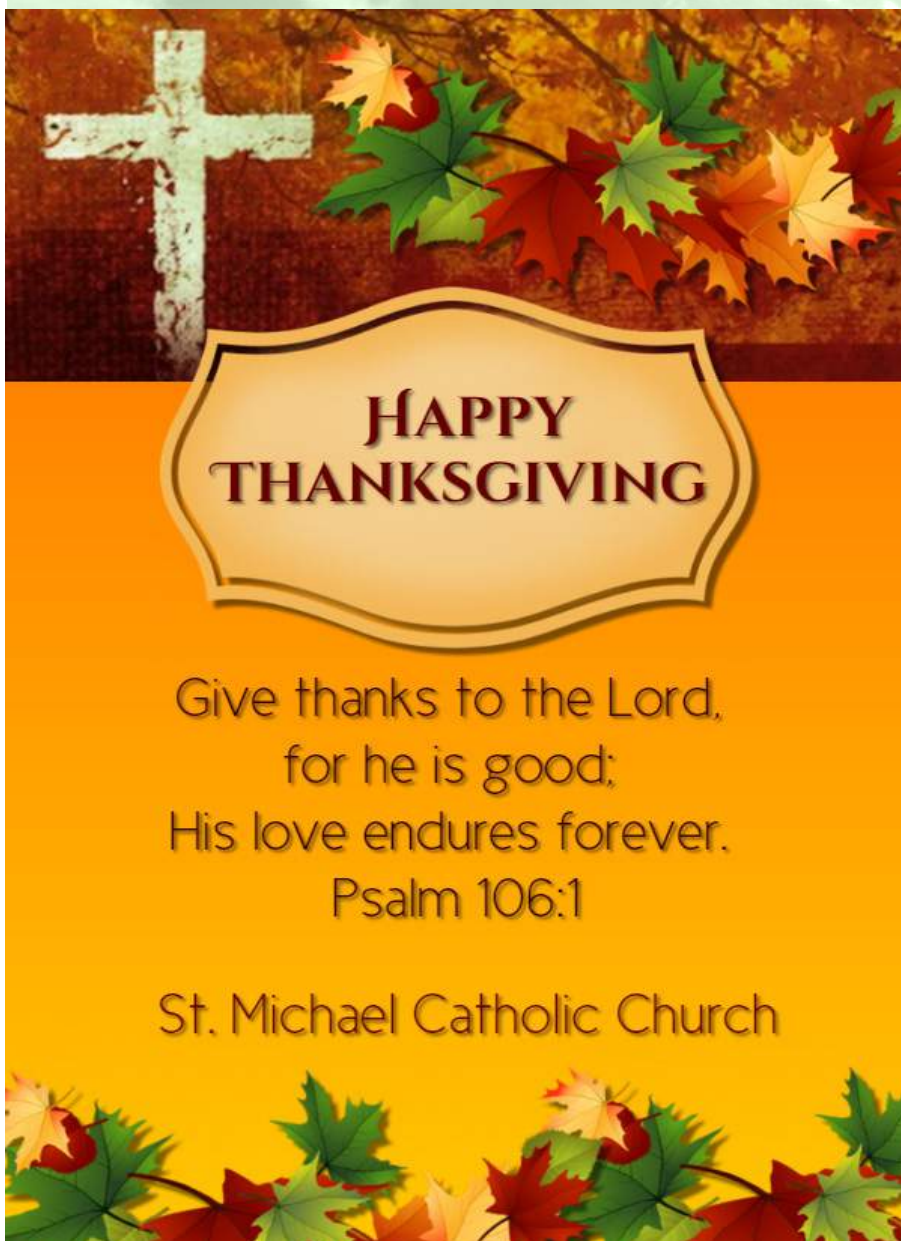

Let us know the full name of the person the Mass is for, whether they are living or deceased and give three dates (per Mass Intention) of dates you would like for us to check the availability of and we will assign the first one available (or the one nearest to the date you requested). Families may request up to four Sunday Masses per year. **SCHEDULING FOR 2019 ONLY – MASSES FILL UP QUICKLY**, so if you have any special dates you'd like to request for the 2019 year, please contact us as soon as possible. ### DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, THE RESPECT LIFE COMMITTEE WILL BE FOCUSING ON THE IMPORTANCE OF FAMILY. THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH TEACHES US THAT:

**2208** – The family should live in such a way that its members learn to care and take responsibility for the young, the old, the sick, the handicapped, and the poor. There are many families who are at times incapable of providing this help. It devolves then on other persons, other families, and, in a subsidiary way, society to provide for their needs: "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction and to keep oneself unstained from the world."

**2210** – The importance of the family for the life and well-being of society entails a particular responsibility for society to support and strengthen marriage and the family. Civil authority should consider it a grave duty "to acknowledge the true nature of marriage and the family, to protect and foster them, to safeguard public morality, and promote domestic prosperity."

**THIS WEEKEND, November 17-18, 2018**, we will have a special opportunity to view products and creations in wood created by the hands of Christian artisans in and around the Holy Land region. The Rishmawi Family has been designated as the representative for these wonderful Christian artisans and has been authorized to show their olive wood carvings.



The tradition of olive wood carvings in the Holy Land has been handed down from father to son since the 12th century. Due to the difficulties the last few years in the Middle East, tourism has been dramatically reduced and these folks have suffered greatly. This is causing the Christian community to emigrate to different countries leaving the Christian population at **2%** today from **25%** ten years ago.

We invite you to visit their display tables and view some of the finest handcrafts available from the Holy Land. This Family strives to bring these fine carvings to our church.

Following the Mass, a Healing Service will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Veneration of relics of the True Cross. Each person then will then have an opportunity to speak individually with one of several priests present to discuss their particular situation and receive a prayer of healing. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will also be available. The Healing Service will conclude with Benediction. All persons who seek Christ's healing are invited – especially those who suffer with physical illness and infirmities (e.g., cancer and other debilitating diseases and conditions), in addition to those seeking emotional and spiritual healing. All caregivers, family members, and members of the medical community are invited, as well. Bimonthly Healing Masses take place at the Cathedral on the third Monday of the month.
