The Catholic Foundation Endowments supporting St. Michael Parish & School

St. Michael Church Continuing Education for Religion Teachers Endowment Fund

This fund provides funding for the education of teachers of religion at St. Michael School and Parish.

St. Michael Athletic Assocation Endowment Fund

This fund provides uniforms, equipment, and the repair and maintenance of the athletic facilities associated with St. Michael Parish and School in Worthington, Ohio.

St. Michael Athletic Assocation Scholarship Endowment Fund

This fund awards scholarships annually to graduating eighth graders, who participated in athletics at St. Michael School in Worthington, Ohio and who are attending a Catholic high school.

In 2013, construction began and was completed on the New Parish Ministry Center which houses the parish offices, Pre-K, Adoration Chapel, and several meeting rooms. The campaign has ended; however, we still have a balance of **\$492,955.00** which was recently increased by **\$119,310.00** to pay for the replacement of the HVAC unit for the school. We welcome all donations in hopes of getting the balance paid off as soon as possible. 
