





### **PRO-LIFE CORNER**

In the Pro-Life Movement, a commonly asked question deals with a person's quality of life. What if my baby is handicapped? Why make my terminally ill mother suffer any longer? To answer questions like these, we must first understand the Catholic Church's teaching on suffering. Consider the following quote:

"Christianity's view of suffering is distinctively its own. Jesus Christ, who went about consoling and

healing the suffering, also taught that it is good to suffer: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted" (Mt 5:3-4). He Himself freely accepted a miserable death as if it were necessary to accomplish the work He had set out to do. He told His followers that they must find a similar place for suffering in their lives. Why? Because "whoever would save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it" (Mt 16:24-25).






### Casino Royale Dinner and Auction at St. Francis DeSales High School


