


"I am the Lord who brought you from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land as a possession." (Genesis 15:7)



## RESPECT LIFE CORNER

Over the next several weeks, the Respect Life Corner will focus on several saints who suffered greatly while on Earth.

### Preserving Dignity of the Human Person - The Story of St. Josephine Bakhita

St. Josephine Bakhita was born in Sudan around the year 1869. At a young age, she was taken from her village and sold into slavery. She was too scared to remember her name, so her captors called her Bakhita, which means lucky or fortunate. Over the next years, she was bought, sold, and treated harshly. Each new owner was a terrifying experience. One owner left 114 scars on her and another owner beat her one leg leaving it permanently injured. Eventually, she was bought by a kind man

named Calisto Legnani who took her to Italy. In Italy, she was given to the Michieli family where she cared for their daughter. When Augusto and Maria Michieli had to return to Sudan, they left both their daughter and Bakhita with the Institute of the Daughters of Charity of Canossa. With the help of the Canossian Sisters, Bakhita earned her freedom, became Catholic, and eventually became a Canossian Sister. She died on February 8, 1947 and was canonized on October 1, 2000.


# Archbishop Chaput, OFM Cap, to Lecture at Josephinum


