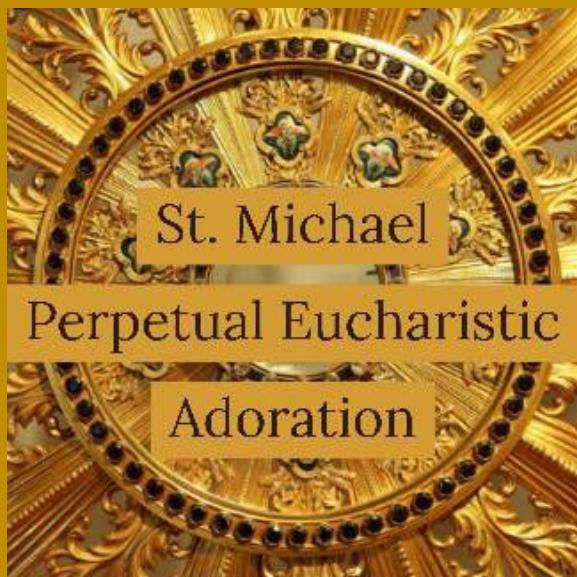
As I renew my resolve each day to become a better person, let me hear Your voice in the deepest reaches of my heart. Give me rest in You.
