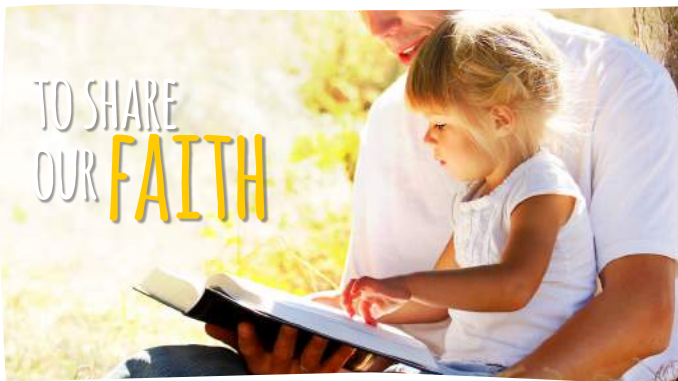
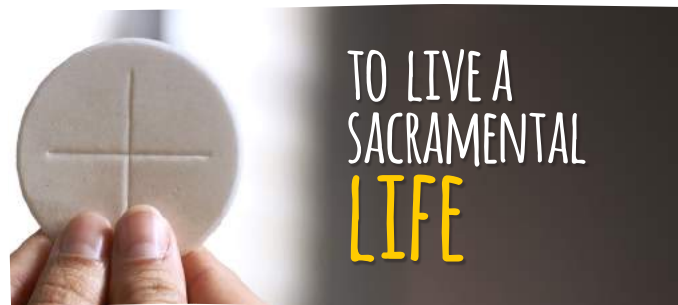

And, for those who were not able to attend the "Our Faith, Our Mission" presentations that I gave in early March, it has been requested that I schedule another opportunity to do so. Those who attended (around 60 people) were very excited about the vision for the parish that was put forth and thought it would be worth presenting again. 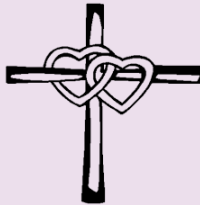

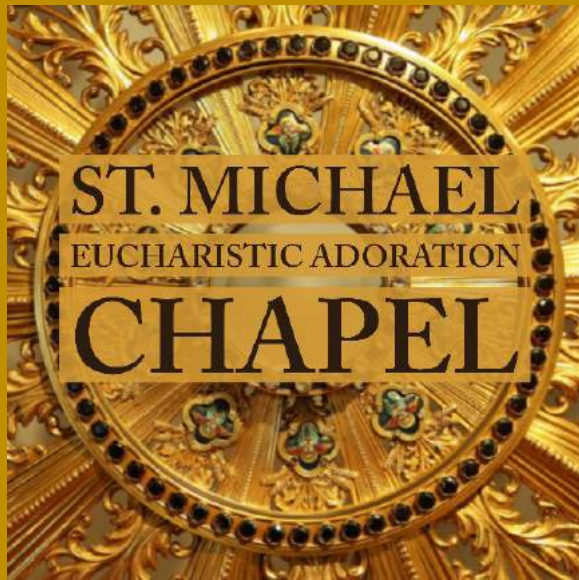

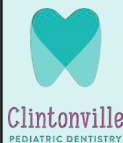
