

Dear Parishioners

"He is Risen! He is Risen! Tell it with a joyful voice!" So begins our proclamation of the Joyful celebration of Easter! Jesus Christ is truly risen from the dead! This news ought to permeate the very being of every believer and follower of Christ, for He is not just one prophet among many, but he is the only Son of God. The Nicene Creed that we proclaim each week recalls that "By the Holy Spirit [He] was Incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man," not for God's own sake, but "For us men and our salvation." Indeed, this Creed which came forth through the Church by the same Holy Spirit gives us the assurances of God's relationship with us and His desire for our Good. Let us therefor always live as His true children and form our lives in the person of Jesus, His Son, our Risen Lord!

Next Sunday, the Last Day of the Easter Octave (the first Eight Days of the Easter Season), is Divine Mercy Sunday. The 12:30 p.m. Mass will conclude with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church. While this continues, Confession will be heard until 3:00 p.m., at which time we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, followed by Benediction. The Blessed Sacrament well then be transferred to the chapel for Adoration as usual.

During the next two months, the Respect Life corner will focus on several saints who suffered greatly while on Earth. This week, we focus on Blessed Margaret of Castello was born of a wealthy, noble Italian family near Florence in 1287. Born a hunchback, dwarf, blind and lame, her family was ashamed of her and kept her hidden in virtual imprisonment for nine years in a tiny cell attached to a forest church. It was only through the family chaplain, that Blessed Margaret came to know God. Seeking a miracle, her parents took her

to a Franciscan Shrine. When she wasn't cured, they abandoned her. Blessed Margaret's faith and courage inspired others in the community to take pity on her and to help her survive. Eventually, she became a member of the Dominican Third Order of Castello, where she lived an exemplary life of prayer, Penance, and charity. Her incorrupt body lies under the main altar in St. Dominic's Church, Castello, Italy. Margaret of Castello was declared Blessed by the Catholic Church on October 19,1609. Blessed Margaret is an inspiration to those who are discouraged and tempted to self-pity.


