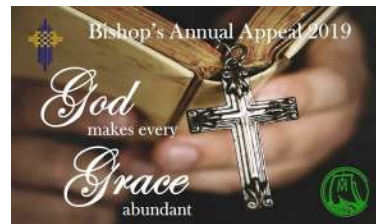

Respect LIFE

During the next two months, the Respect Life corner will focus on several saints who suffered greatly while on Earth. The third saint that the Respect Life corner will focus on is **St. John Vianney, or Cure d'Ars**. St. John Vianney grew up during the French Revolution and had to attend Mass in secret. Despite the war, he remained faithful and wanted to become a priest. As a young man, he entered the seminary where he struggled with learning and he was asked to leave. Fr. Balley, a priest friend, helped him with his studies and encouraged him to go back. At the seminary, St. John Vianney failed the exam. Once again, Fr. Balley helped him by finding a bishop who was willing to ordain him. After Ordination, he was assigned to work with Fr. Balley, but he was not permitted to hear Confessions. (This decision was eventually changed.) After Fr. Balley's death, St. John Vianney was sent to the small town of Ars. St. John Vianney wanted to bring people back to the faith. He ate very little and lived mostly on potatoes. His holiness led to many conversions and people came from all over to see him. He would spend up to 18 hours per day in the Confessional, which was very hot in the summer and very cold in the winter. In his 70s and sick, he continued to hear Confessions until several days before his death on August 4, 1859. He was canonized on May 31, 1925.

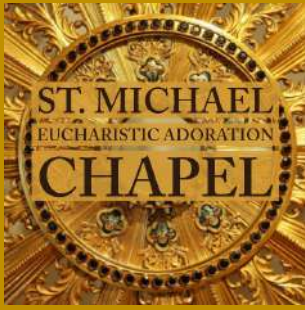
