

Farewell from Fr. Lynch



This spring, Father Dinovo has inspired the faithful of Saint Michael's by preaching the mission of the Catholic Church, specifically the mission of Saint Michael's, and proclaiming the FAITH FORMATION gospel with new vigor through his vision, Our Faith, Our Mission.


The goal of our Faith Formation programming is to support and empower families to be active missionary disciples within their home, school, and parish through faith formation, prayer, and community.


