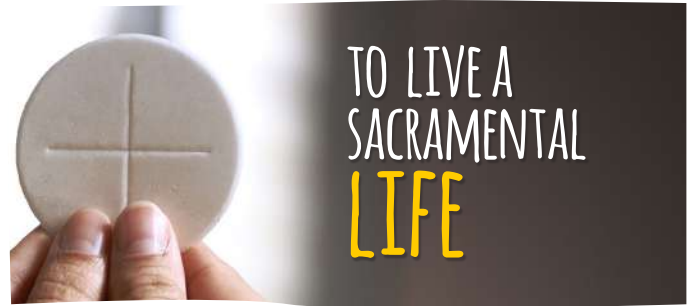

Please join us this weekend after all Masses for our farewell to Fr. Lynch before he leaves for his new assignment in July. Please make sure you come and wish him well.

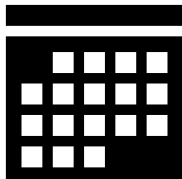

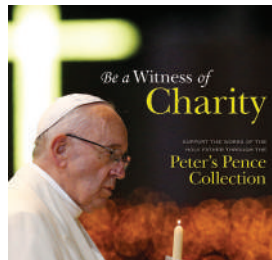
### Farewell from Fr. Lynch

We are excited to announce our upcoming plan for family faith formation at Saint Michael Parish. This spring, Father Dinovo has inspired the faithful of Saint Michael's by preaching the mission of the Catholic Church, specifically the mission of Saint Michael's, and proclaiming the Gospel with new vigor through his vision, *Our Faith, Our Mission*.

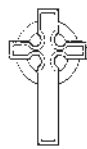
