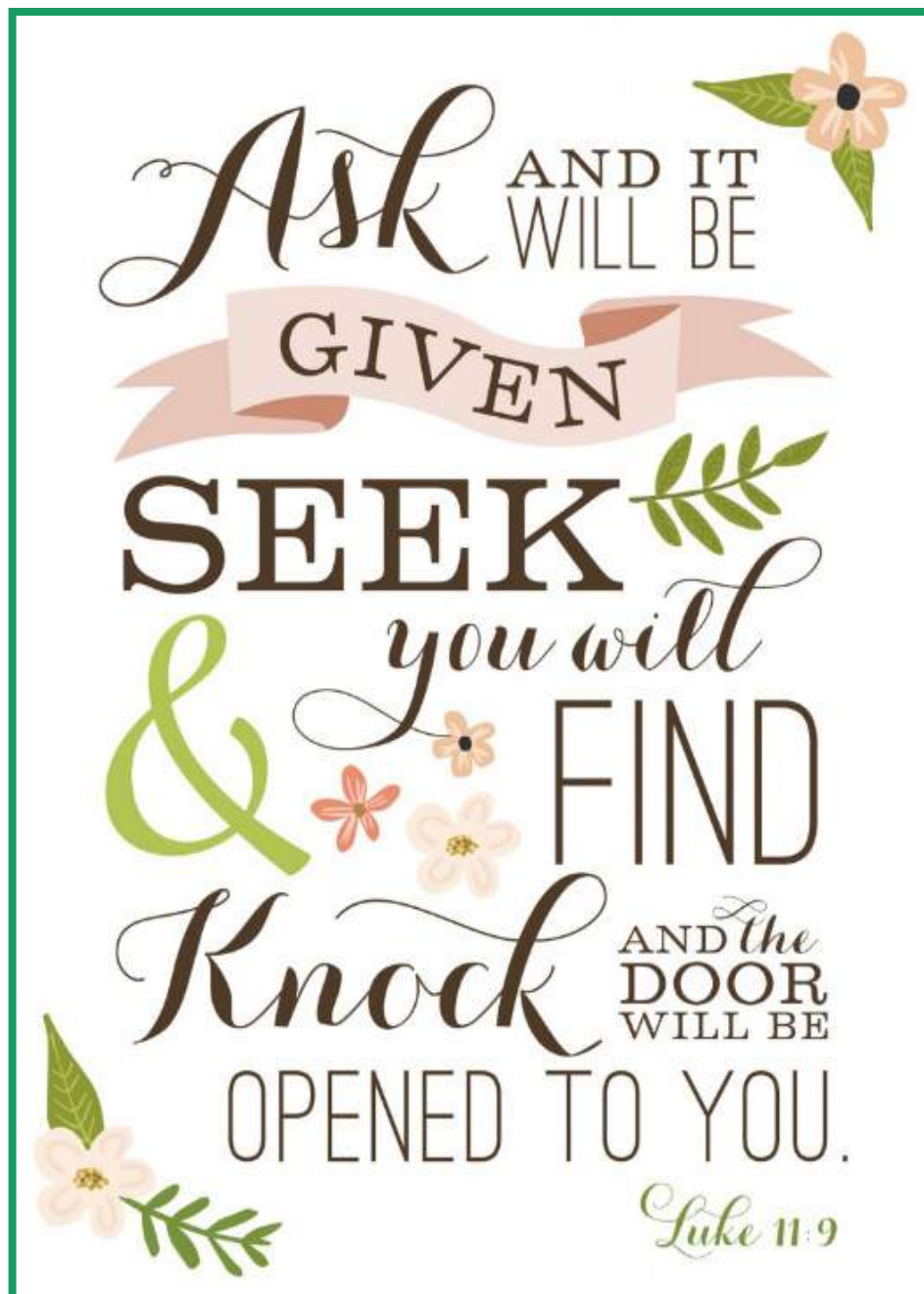

PSR Information for Fall 2019-2020

Faith Formation Classes will be from 6:15 p.m.-7:30 p.m. on Mondays, beginning on September 16th.

On the first Faith Formation Class of each month, we will be having a Family Catechesis night. The format of the night will be catechetical teaching on God's Plan of Salvation, with K-5th, 6th-8th, and parent sessions teaching the same subjects at different levels. Then, all the families will gather together for Prayer, Worship, and Adoration.

The rest of the month, PSR for all grades will be held on Monday evenings, from 6:15-7:30 p.m. These classes will be related to the teaching taught on Family Catechesis nights. All of the Faith Formation class will be learning the same content at age-appropriate levels with appropriate grade-level activities.

RESPECT LIFE

For the summer, the Respect Life Corner will focus on the importance of marriage.

Let us reflect on the words of Pope Pius VIII in his encyclical Traditi Humilitati, "the sacrament of matrimony ought to be governed not so much by human law as by divine law and that it ought to be counted among sacred, not earthly, concerns.

Thus, it is wholly subject to the Church. Formerly marriage had no other purpose than that of bringing children into the world. But now it has been raised to the dignity of a sacrament by Christ the Lord and enriched with heavenly gifts. Now its purpose is not so much to generate offspring as to educate children for God and for religion. This increases the number of worshipers of the true divinity.

It is agreed that the union of marriage signifies the perpetual and sublime union of Christ with His Church; as a result, the close union of husband and wife is a sacrament, that is, a sacred sign of the immortal love of Christ for His spouse."

What: The Great Hymnal Changeover Project

When: August 10th, at 9:00 a.m. – Must be complete promptly by 12:00 noon (wedding at 1:00 p.m.)

Needs on the day of: We need a team leader and enough people to fold 2,100 Mass Pew inserts, remove the old hymnals from the pews and replace with new hymnals with Mass pew inserts inside, then box up the old hymnals so they can be moved to their new home. Those exchanging the hymnals need to be able to move quickly through the pews and lift boxes of about 25 lbs. each.

Need before August 10th: We need a group to come in and fold 2,100 Mass pew cards in half and keep them organized by color. This project can be done anytime between now and August 10th, so they'll be ready to insert on the day of the changeover.

Dear members of our St. Michael Parish and School Community,

We are grateful to our School Advisory Board for advancing the "Vertical Platform Lift" to add handicap access to the gym and the lower level of St. Michael School. After consultation with the diocesan facilities office and with the assistance of board member and architect, Chris Meyers, we have determined that a vertical platform lift is most advisable option. The lift would be installed parallel to the gym stairs.

We are pleased to share that we have already received \$13,000.00 towards our goal of approximately \$36,000.00. Of those funds, \$4,000.00 has been donated by our good Knights of Columbus, and \$4,000.00 from our St. Michael Athletic Association. We are deeply grateful to our Knights and SMAA for their dedication to our parishioners and school community. Please consider joining this endeavor, as we would love to install this over the summer.

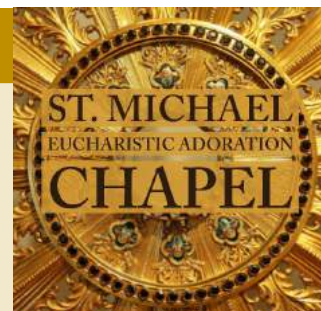
