Volunteer Opportunity!

<u>When</u>:

August 10th, at 9:00 a.m. Must be completed promptly by 12:00 noon (wedding at 1:00 p.m.).

Who:

- **10 volunteers** who are able to move quickly and lift at least 25 lbs. to move the old hymnals out of the pews and box them up, remove the paper missalettes and discard them and then put the new hymnals in the pews.
- <u>5+ volunteers</u> who are able to sit at a table and stuff the folded Mass pew cards into the backs of each new hymnal before they are placed in the pew (no lifting involved, but must be able to move quickly).
- <u>**1 volunteer**</u> who is able to oversee and make sure everything runs smoothly (no lifting involved just answer questions, make sure everything is completed as planned).

Dear members of our St. Michael Parish and School community,

We are grateful to our School Advisory Board for advancing the "Vertical Platform Lift" to add handicap access to the gym and the lower level of St. Michael School. After consultation with the Diocesan Facilities Office and with the assistance of board member and architect, Chris Meyers, we have determined that a vertical platform lift is the most advisable option. The lift would be installed parallel to the gym stairs.

We are pleased to share that we have already received \$13,000.00 towards our goal of approximately \$36,000.00. Of those funds, \$4,000.00 has been

donated by our good Knights of Columbus and \$4,000.00 from our St. Michael Athletic Association. We are deeply grateful to our Knights and SMAA for their dedication to our parishioners and school community. Please consider joining this endeavor, as we would love to install this over the summer.
