

#### Mass Intentions - How to request

In order to offer the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the following quidelines have been established:

- 1. We are no longer able to accept Mass requests via phone.
- 2. All Mass requests <u>must be submitted in writing</u> using the Mass Intention Request Form. The form can be found on our website at <u>www.saintmichael-cd.org</u>, or in the box marked "Mass Intention Forms" located in Marian Hall.
- 3. The suggested stipend in the Diocese of Columbus is \$10.00 per Mass. This stipend must be included with the form at the time of scheduling.
- 4. You may return the completed form and stipend in an envelope clearly marked "Mass Requests" to the Parish Office during regular business hours, mailing it, or placing it in the weekend collection basket. Masses will be scheduled in the order that request forms are received. In the event that the date you requested is not available, we will choose the next available Mass for the Mass time you requested.
- 5. Each family/group is limited to 12 total Mass Intention requests per calendar year. Of those, only four of those may be Saturday Vigil/Sunday Masses.
- 6. Mass Intention requests may be made for the rest of the 2019 calendar year and the 2020 calendar year. We are unable to accept Mass requests beyond this time frame.

#### PSR Information for Fall 2019-2020 - REGISTRATION OPEN NOW


Faith Formation Classes (PSR) will be from 6:10 p.m.-7:30 p.m. on Mondays beginning on September 16th.

#### **AROUND THE DIOCESE**



St. Vincent de Paul Microloan Program Financial Mentor Training - The Society of St. Vincent de Paul started a small loan program to help our neighbors, who have little or no access to regular loans through banks, avoid payday lenders. We started our program in Licking County in fall of 2016 and expanded the program to six additional counties, including Coshocton, Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Knox, and Ross Counties in 2018-2019. The Microloan program

is growing rapidly, and we need your help. We are currently looking for people who are willing to be financial mentors to borrowers in our loan program. Microloans have improved the lives of our borrowers by providing not only the low interest loans, but also by providing access to a financial mentor who can work with the person to improve credit scores and increase the understanding and use of a variety of financial tools. We know from the experiences of our current mentors and borrowers, that this relationship has positively impacted everyone involved. The curriculum includes tips on relationship building, background about the Microloan program, understanding poverty, and an introduction to using financial empowerment tools, including Your Money, Your Goals from the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau. Those who are interested in becoming a financial mentor, including previously trained mentors who want a refresher, are invited to register online by September 18. You can also call or text Deb Zabloudil at 614-507-5345. Lunch and materials are provided by St. Vincent de Paul Systemic Change programs. Registration is required so we can insure that we have adequate food and materials for those who come. You do not need to be a member of St. Vincent de Paul to be a financial mentor.
