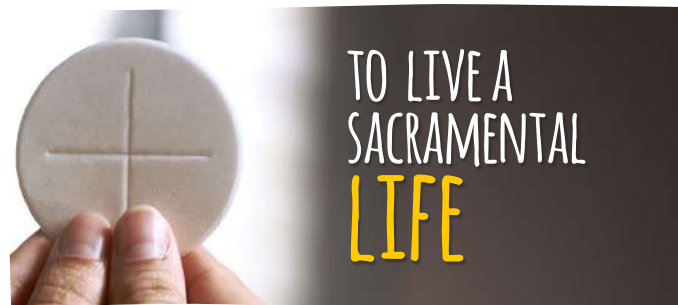

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE DIOCESE



"As you know there have been many attempts to use the good names of our bishops, priests, deacons, religious, teachers and others to falsely solicit unsuspecting persons for help, usually in the form of fake e-mails and fake text messages asking people to purchase gift cards for worthy causes.

The most recent scam is rather important, because it involves the Holy Family Soup Kitchen, which is well-known in our Diocese, the Holy Family Food Pantry, and other charitable activities associated with Holy Family Parish and Father Stash Dailey.

Please use whatever means necessary to warn your parishioners about this scam, using Father Dailey's name and perhaps tying it in with Holy Family activities, the James Cancer Hospital; you name it. Father Dailey did contact the Columbus Police Department about this. Please spread the word so that no one is taken by this scam."

Remember to be alert and delete and block. Do not respond to any private emails or texts from any clergy requesting money, gift cards, money transfers or vague requests for help as they do not contact parishioners privately.

2020 MASS INTENTION CALENDAR IS NOW OPEN

ST. MICHAEL CATHOLIC CHURCH GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING MASS INTENTIONS



In order to offer the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the following guidelines have been established:

1. All Mass requests must be submitted in writing using this Mass Intention Request Form. The form can be found on our website at www.saintmichael-cd.org. You will also find forms in Marian Hall, at the Parish Office and in the pamphlet holders around the church. Please submit one form per Mass requested.
2. The suggested stipend in the Diocese of Columbus is \$10.00 per Mass. This stipend must be included with the form at the time of scheduling (cash or checks payable to St. Michael Catholic Church).
3. **Each family/group is limited to 12 total Mass Intention requests per calendar year. Of those, only four may be Saturday Vigil/Sunday Masses. Please submit one form for each request.**
4. You may return the completed form and stipend in an envelope clearly marked "Mass Requests" by dropping it in any offering basket during the weekend Masses, bringing it to the Parish Office, or by mailing it to the address on the front of this form. Masses will be scheduled in the order that request forms are received. In the event that the date you requested is not available, we will choose the next available Mass for the Mass time you requested.
5. Mass Intention requests may be made for the rest of the 2019 calendar year and the 2020 calendar year. We are unable to accept Mass requests beyond this time frame.

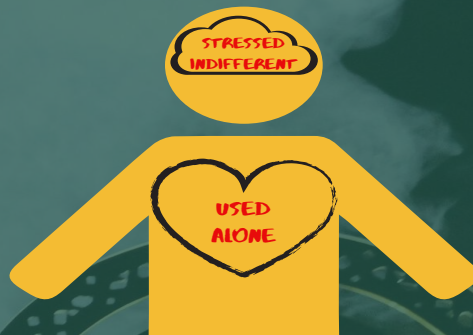

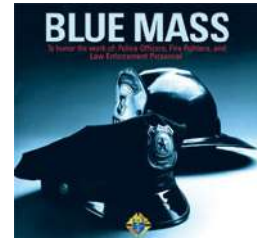
