



2020 MASS INTENTION CALENDAR IS NOW OPEN

ST. MICHAEL CATHOLIC CHURCH **GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING** MASS INTENTIONS



In order to offer the opportunity for all parishioners to schedule a Mass Intention for their loved ones and to accommodate recently deceased individuals, the following guidelines have been established:

- 1. All Mass requests <u>must be submitted in writing</u> using this Mass Intention Request Form. The form can be found on our website at www. saintmichael-cd.org. You will also find forms in Marian Hall, at the Parish Office and in the pamphlet holders around the church. Please submit one form per Mass requested.
- 2. The suggested stipend in the Diocese of Columbus is \$10.00 per Mass. This stipend must be included with the form at the time of scheduling (cash or checks payable to St. Michael Catholic Church).
- 3. Each family/group is limited to 12 total Mass Intention requests per calendar year. Of those, only four may be Saturday Vigil/Sunday Masses. Please submit one form for each request.
- 4. You may return the completed form and stipend in an envelope clearly marked "Mass Requests" by dropping it in any offering basket during the weekend Masses, bringing it to the Parish Office, or by mailing it to the address on the front of this form. Masses will be scheduled in the order that request forms are received. In the event that the date you requested is not available, we will choose the next available Mass for the Mass time you requested.
- 5. Mass Intention requests may be made for the rest of the 2019 calendar year and the 2020 calendar year. We are unable to accept Mass requests beyond this time frame.






