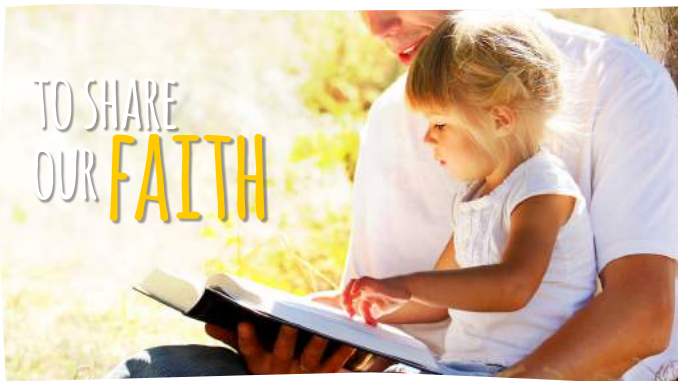
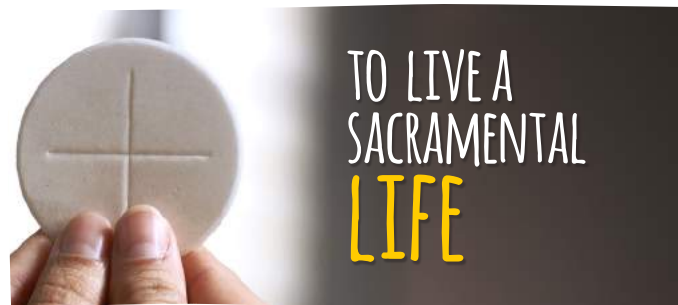

### St. Michael the Archangel Feast Day Potluck

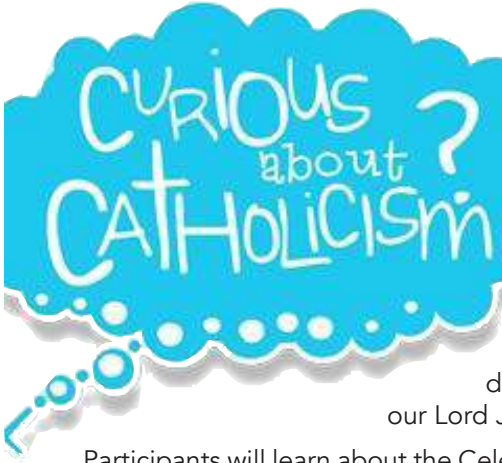

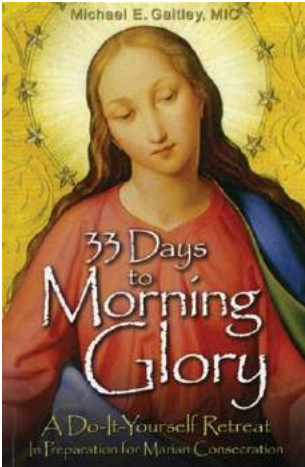

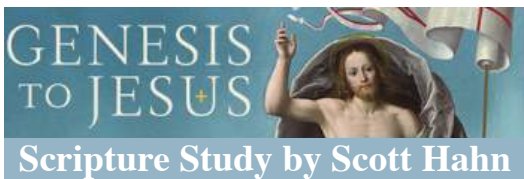
