TIME: 10:30 A.M. MASS



Each card includes an inspiring quote inside. The back of each card includes a definition of the featured virtue as well as the student artist's personal reflection on how they encourage others to live that virtue.












Brothers and sisters,

I'm sure most of you are aware of the horrific sexual abuse crisis that has haunted our Church, especially in recent months. We all grieve the wicked ways that priests have abused children, seminarians, and other vulnerable people. I know many of us feel, understandably, demoralized and defeated.



With these scandals in mind and in consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council, we are going to share with you a new book by Bishop Robert Barron. Bishop Barron is a bishop in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and he's the founder of Word on Fire Catholic Ministries. His book is titled *Letter to a Suffering Church: A Bishop Speaks on the Sexual Abuse Crisis*. We will make available a copy of the book for every family in the parish (while supplies last), and I think you'll find it helpful and uplifting. These books will be made available beginning the weekend of October 26-27 after all Masses. After that weekend, we will make them available at other times.

Also, for those who are interested, as a follow-up to the book, we are planning two opportunities for further discussion and reflection. The first opportunity will be a 2-hour discussion session that will take place on Sunday November 10th at 7:00pm which will be held here at the parish. We will ask that if you are interested in attending this that you please contact our parish office 614-885-7814, or send us an email at office@saintmichael-cd.org letting us know. This will help us to have an idea on the number of people who are interested so that we can plan accordingly.

The second opportunity will utilize 5 video presentations created by Bishop Barron's team and will be accessible through the FLOCKNOTE platform. Information on how to sign up for that will be forthcoming.

Again, our parish has ordered a copy of this new book for every family in the parish, and my hope is that you read it slowly and attentively. Then after finishing the book, I encourage you to pass it on to a friend or family member who could use it, to anyone struggling with the Church during this crisis.

So please make sure to take a copy of the book once they are available and know that we at St. Michael the Archangel Parish care deeply about helping you navigate these stormy waters.
