

Formed Advent Series Week 2: Trust in God with Brigid DeMoor

"RADICAL REORIENTATION CAN START TODAY"

When we hear the words of the prophet Isaiah, "Prepare the way of the Lord" we often think of a history session about what was said thousands of years ago or that's our cue to decorate our house for Christmas when we get home from Mass. The funny thing is, those words are speaking directly to you and your own heart. When we have company come over for Christmas, we scour the house cleaning, plug in air fresheners, and do last minute home improvements. But what do we do to receive the Lord in our own heart? What do we do before every Mass to prepare to literally receive Jesus' Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Holy Eucharist?

Okay, here's the elephant in the room: we're all sinners. There, I said it! We all sin. You're not special. Well, you are... but not when it comes to sin. To "prepare the way of the Lord" we must clean up our sin in order to fix our eyes totally on Jesus. You see, our God is jealous for you. He can't stand the thought that your heart is divided because of sin. He wants your entire, undivided heart. He wants you! As uncomfortable as this may be, step number one is to repent. No doubt about it. Interior repentance is a "radical reorientation of our whole life" (CCC 1431). Yes, that's intimidating but with God's grace you can do it! Don't wait for January 1st to make a "radical reorientation." Repent (today!), "for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

While 25% of our students come from other parishes, all our students are actively engaged and connected with parish ministries. Recent examples include:


