

THOSE WHOM THE LORD HAS RANSOMED SHALL RETURN." – ISAIAH 35:10

Ransom (verb): to free from captivity or punishment by paying a price.

Wait, but I live in America. I'm as free as they come! What in the world do I need saved from? Well let us ask you this. Have you ever done something you knew you shouldn't do-but you did it anyway (Rom 7:19)? We do all the time! Why? Because on our own, without God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit, we are powerless to overcome sin. As important as repentance is, it's not enough for us to just repent; we need to be delivered from the tyranny of sin.

Enter Jesus...God has put on flesh to fight the battle that we could never win on our own. He has come to His people and set them free-free from the power of Death, free from the dominion of Sin and free from Satan's grip. He did this because you're worth dying for. You have been ransomed. You have been set free by the Blood of Jesus poured out on the cross. This is extraordinary news! In response, spend some time this week reflecting on Jesus. Who is utterly unconquerable, and His decision to save you, to ransom you, from the bondage of sin.

"Who is he who contends with me? Let him stand in opposition to me. I set the condemned man free; I gave the dead man life; I raised up the one who had been entombed. Who is my opponent? I, he says, am the Christ. I am the one who destroyed death, and triumphed over the enemy, and trampled Hades under foot, and bound the strong one...This is the alpha and the omega. This is the beginning and the end-an indescribably beginning and an incomprehensible end. This is the Christ. This is the king. This is Jesus. This is the general. This is the Lord. This is the one who rose up from the dead. This is the one who sits at the right hand of the Father." – Melito of Sardis, an early Church Father, given in an Easter vigil homily, 2nd century.
