

### DEAR PARISHIONERS,

Monday, February 3rd, is the memorial of St. Blaise. After Masses on that day, as well as Saturday Evening, February 1st and Sunday, February 2nd, clergy will be available for the annual Blessing of Throats.

On Sunday, February 9th, our parish will be celebrating World Marriage Day. One aspect of our celebration will be a photo display in the gathering space featuring YOUR wedding photos! We invite all married couples to email office@saintmichael-cd.org, or drop off one unframed wedding photo to the parish office. Please include your last name, phone number, and wedding date (including the year) on the back of the photo or include that info in your email. Photos will need to be turned in to the parish office by Thursday, February 6th. After World Marriage Day, your photos can be picked up from the parish office. The gift of your commitment to each other is a beautiful witness to our parish family!

Tuesday, February 11th is the memorial feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and is the World Day of the Sick, "a special time of prayer and sharing, of offering one's own suffering for the good of the Church, and of reminding us to see in our sick brother and sister the face of Christ who, by suffering, dying, and rising, achieved the salvation of the human race" (St. Pope John Paul II, *Letter Instituting the World Day of the Sick*, 13 May 1992, #3). On that day, as well as after the Masses on February 8th and 9th, the priests of the parish will be available for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and/or to pray for your health intentions. Those of the Catholic Faithful who are able to receive Holy Communion under normal circumstances and suffer from chronic physical ailments, those preparing for surgery, and the elderly may present themselves for the reception of the Sacrament of Anointing. If anyone does not wish to be anointed but would like to have a priest pray over them, then they may do so by indicating their intention to the priest. A person does not have to be Catholic to have a priest pray over them.
