

DEAR PARISHIONERS.

Tuesday February 11th is the memorial feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and is the World Day of the Sick. On that day, as well as after the Sunday Masses on February 8th & 9th, the priests of the parish will be available for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and/or to pray for your health intentions. Those of the Catholic Faithful who are able to receive Holy Communion under normal circumstances and suffer from chronic physical ailments, those preparing for surgery, and the elderly may present themselves for the reception of the Sacrament of Anointing. If anyone does not wish to be anointed but would like to have a priest pray over them, then they may do so by indicating their intention to the priest. A person does not have to be Catholic to have a priest pray over them.

Ash Wednesday will be on February 26th. Mass Times will be posted in the Bulletin and on the Parish Website.

The Days of Abstinence and Fasting during Lent and the Sacred Triduum are as follows:

Abstinence – Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days these faithful are not to eat meat.

Fasting – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted but combined should not be more than one full meal.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed as usual on Fridays during Lent beginning at 7:30 p.m.






