

DEAR PARISHIONERS.

Our parish office staff often get requests from people asking for letters of good standing for the purposes of being Godparents for a Baptism or as Sponsors for Confirmation. We are happy to accommodate these requests; however, on numerous occasions we are unable to do so as individuals are either not registered or there is no indication of any participation in the life of the parish, especially through regular attendance and participation in the Mass. Because of the importance that these roles have in the lives of those who are being baptized and/or confirmed, please understand that when these requests are being made, it is the pastor's responsibility to report as accurately as possible the information that is requested. Last minute registration makes it especially difficult to give the kind of testimony needed. In choosing a Godparent or Sponsor, please be mindful of this and encourage those chosen to "up their game" if need be, in regard to their own faith life. They should be registered and actively practicing and contributing to the life of the parish for at least six months in order to receive a letter of good standing.

Ash Wednesday will be on February 26th. Mass Times will be posted in the Bulletin and on the Parish Website.

The Days of Abstinence and Fasting during Lent and the Sacred Triduum are as follows:

Abstinence – Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. The Law of Abstinence binds all those who have completed their 14th year of age and older. On those days, these faithful are not to eat meat.

Fasting – Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. The Law of Fasting binds all from the age of 18 through the end of the 59th year. The Law of Fasting prescribes that only one full meal a day be taken. Two lighter meals are permitted but combined should not be more than one full meal.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed as usual on Fridays during Lent beginning at 7:30 p.m.
