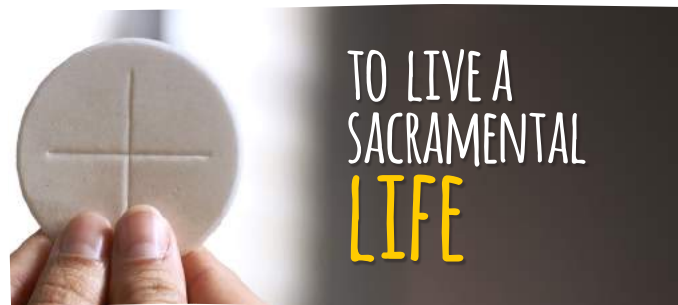

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

First, thank you to Fr. Adam Streitenberger for his fantastic presentation for our Parish Mission this week. His commitment to the Church and Evangelization is very evident from his own enthusiasm and joy. I pray that all who were able to attend are now ready to live the New Evangelization and become "Missionary Disciples" in a new "Revolution" and a life of "Authenticity." We will be making the recordings of the mission talks available on our parish website for all who would like to listen to his words of wisdom.

Second, congratulations to Msgr. John Cody, a retired priest of our diocese and a son of St. Michael Parish for being named as "Irish Man of the Year" by the Shamrock Club! God bless you, Msgr. Cody. We are proud of you!

Third, recently the priests of the diocese received a communication from Bishop Brennan regarding concerns about the spread of the Coronavirus. More information on this will be found on our parish website. "In regard to our liturgical practice, we exercise the same prudence and charity taken during any influenza season" states Bishop Brennan. The short of it is that, at present, I do not anticipate removing the offering of the Precious Blood at the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Sunday Masses nor telling parishioners they cannot shake hands at the sign of peace. Parishioners, Clergy and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist are reminded of the following:

- If you are ill or even experiencing symptoms of illness, you are not obliged to attend Mass, and, in fact, in a spirit of charity should not attend Mass or other functions.
- Please take proper measures to practice good hygiene: washing of hands (parents especially help educate your children) use hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes whenever possible.
- Regarding the Precious Blood, the laity are not required to receive from the chalice. Receiving the host alone is sufficient for your Communion. If you have a cold or suspect you are ill in anyway, then please be charitable and not receive from the chalice.
- Please exercise good judgment regarding coughing, sneezing, the shaking of hands, and keeping surfaces clean. If you do not wish to shake hands at the sign of peace, you may offer another sign, such as a soft-spoken greeting and slight bow of the head. If someone does not offer their hand, please do not take offense. It's nothing personal.

A LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL

With appreciation for our pastor, Fr. Dinovo, and the financial support of St. Michael parish, I am pleased to share the 2020/2021 tuition information.

The non-participating rate for tuition in 2020-2021 will be \$6,980 per child, an increase of \$268.

- The first child participating rate will be \$4,540, an increase of \$176.
- The second child participating rate will be \$3,840, an increase of \$148.
- The third child participating rate will be \$3,140, an increase of \$120.
- The fourth and fifth child participating rate will be \$2,000, an increase of \$800.

Participating rates apply to families whose pastor has signed the parish subsidy form to pay the difference between the non-participating rate and the participating rate.

Tuition assistance is available to help bridge the gap for families who need it. We will customize financial support to work with families, so their children attend St. Michael next year. Please contact me at srjp@cducation.org so we can take the first steps to assist you.

Be sure to apply for FACTS before March 15, as this allows tuition grants to come from the diocese, rather than only from our parish or Tuition Assistance Endowment. (www.factstuitionaid.com/)

In order to qualify for financial aid in diocesan Catholic schools, an application should be submitted at a Catholic school by March 15. If you have not yet done so, please submit your online application today at: <https://www.stmichaelworthington.org/apply>

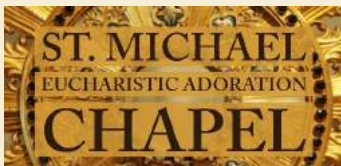

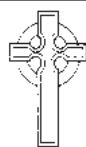
