

#### DEAR PARISHIONERS,

I want to sincerely thank, once again, all of those volunteers who have worked so hard at assisting with our reopening efforts. Last week, the Parish Pastoral Council members led us off with the initial opening and they did a fantastic job of welcoming people back as aiding with the sanitizing of the church pews and other areas according to the proper protocols. This weekend, we have members of the Eucharistic Adoration Team who will be here.

From our experience last week, there are three things to note: 1) When using hand sanitizer at Communion, please do so after you remove or lower your mask; 2) also make sure your hands are dry before receiving Communion (take your time, there is no rush); and 3) we are using sanitizing agents that are the least abrasive on wood surfaces, but still effective in eliminating the Coronavirus when done according to the recommended procedures (which we follow). Please do not bring other sanitizing solutions or material (i.e. Clorox, Lysol wipes, etc.) as these are much more abrasive on wood.

Last Saturday evening, at a special Mass, members of our RCIA class were received into the Catholic Church. Their names are listed elsewhere in the bulletin and on the parish digital signage. Please welcome them and keep them in your prayers. God bless RCIA class of 2020! And welcome aboard!

This weekend, we will begin having students of our 2nd Grade school and PSR program receiving their First Holy Communion during the Sunday Masses in the Month of June. There will be about 4 students at each Mass. Pray for them as they have been waiting for this moment for a long time.

Next weekend, through the Grace of God and the Imposition of Hands by Bishop Robert Brennan, Deacon Frank Brown, a member of our parish, together with Deacons Michael Fulton and Seth Keller, will be ordained to the Priesthood. The soon to be Father Frank Brown will celebrate his First Mass of Thanksgiving at the 12:30 p.m. Mass. Please keep him in your prayers as he begins his life as a priest for the Diocese of Columbus.
