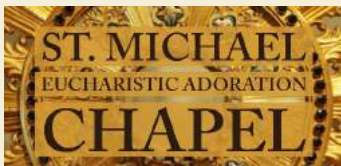
SEASONS OF HOPE BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY

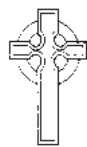
