

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

We are getting closer to the opening of school for our St. Michael students. Our principal, Sr. John Paul, O.P., the reopening committee, and our school and office staff have been working very hard to get things ready. I ask for your continued prayers for them, as well as for our teachers and school families, as they prepare for this school year.

As we look to the opening of school, you may notice some changes in the way other parish buildings are being utilized, particularly the undercroft/cafeteria, Marian Hall (both levels) and the Parish Ministry Center. These accommodations have become especially necessary in order to facilitate the requirements for reopening of schools. For instance, since these buildings will be utilized more by the school, it will be necessary to treat them as an extension of the school building and take security measures to access the buildings by others, including the Church. The closer we get to the opening of the school, more details will be given on what these changes will be.

Also, the Diocese is continuing to work on the next phase of parish reopening and is offering direction on new policies and guidelines. More information will be coming soon. Please check the parish website for more updates.




Rosary Novena for Peace in Our Country
