



AROUND THE PARISH

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

We have now been given the go ahead to have priests, deacons and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to take communion to those who are homebound. This may also include parishioners who are in the high-risk group who have been staying at home because of the pandemic. It is necessary for everyone to follow the precautions for social distancing, wearing of masks, washing and sanitizing of hands, etc. Individuals who are to receive the Eucharist (and their family members, if possible) should be consulted to determine their comfort level of having the Eucharist brought to them in their homes. Please note this does not include those who reside in nursing homes or are in hospitals, as many of them are still under visitor restrictions.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who would like to volunteer are asked to contact the parish office. Only Extraordinary Ministers who are not in the high-risk category should consider volunteering.

Also, for those of our Parish and School PSR students who were to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation last year but were delayed because of the pandemic, you should have received by now information on signing up for time slots for your child(ren) to be confirmed at some upcoming Sunday Masses. If you have not, then please contact the PSR or School Office for information.

I want to thank those who have been so generous with their pledges toward the Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA). As I mentioned in my homily on the kick-off weekend for the BAA, since the beginning of the pandemic, many parishioners have asked me if I knew of anyone who needed help and how they can assist them. Well, here is your chance to step up and give so that many throughout our diocese may receive the help they need. As of the writing of this message we have reached \$113,129.07 in pledges toward our parish goal of \$130,956.46. That puts us at \$17,827.39 shy of our goal. 
