

Service Hours

Service is a core mission value of the Catholic Church. The service hours for 8th grade are meant to be an introduction for the students to find a way that they enjoy serving the church and find where their gifts and talents are.

This year, we are adapting our options to make service hours accessible to students. We will be requiring 10 hours of service. The service hour form is for all hours of service and can be turned in by **March 6th**.

The 3 part Confirmation Retreat will each count for an hour of service. We will be bringing in different local non-profits to teach about what they do and how we can support them as a community.

The 7 hours remaining can be used for the child to find different ways they desire to serve the church and their local community. Depending on COVID regulations, some may be easier than others.

Options can include:

- Collecting and delivering items to a food drive
- Making blankets to give to a homeless shelter
- Participating in a toy or clothing drive
- Writing letters to retired Priests or Religious
- Volunteering at a race for a cause
- Going to a community park to pick up litter
- Making a meal for a family who has lost a loved one, a family that had a new child, or a family in need
- Creating care bags for the homeless in Columbus
- Volunteering at the Fish Fry
