

AROUND THE PARISH

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

It's hard to believe that this would have been the weekend of our annual parish festival, but, as you know, because of the Coronavirus pandemic we had to cancel this year. We ask that you please remember to support the businesses that have supported us with their contributions over the last several years by their kind donations. God bless them and you for your patronage.

The chancery office has asked us to bring to your attention two important special collection notifications:


- Holy Land Good Friday collection update: Many pastors this past week received a letter from the Commissariat for the Holy Land in Washington, D.C. requesting that the annual Holy Land Good Friday collection be taken the weekend of September 12-13, as approved by Pope Francis. The Good Friday collection this year was not taken up as usual due to the pandemic. There was still solid support for this collection throughout April and May despite the Coronavirus, but the overall amount collected was, nevertheless, down significantly. Anyone still wishing to make a donation to this may do so through the second weekend of October. All proceeds will then be forwarded to the Diocesan Finance Office by October 21 through the usual procedures.
- Hurricane Laura/California wildfires: The USCCB has requested a special collection for Hurricane Laura and California wildfires relief. This special appeal will become part of the Bishop's Emergency Disaster Fund and will be used to support the efforts of Catholic Charities USA and/or Catholic Relief Services, the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs for these and other disasters in our country that will occur. Pastors are asked to set a date for this special collection this fall that works best with their parish calendar and to forward these funds to the Diocesan Finance Office via the usual procedures as well. I am asking that we consider having this completed around Thanksgiving Day, which is November 26th this year.

While there will be no physical second collection taken up, if you desire to contribute to either of these, please place them in separate envelopes clearly marked for the intended collection and drop it in the regular collection basket. Checks should be made out to St. Michael Parish.

I want to thank those who have been so generous with their pledges toward the Bishop's Annual Appeal (BAA). As I mentioned in my homily on the kick-off weekend for the BAA, since the beginning of the pandemic, many parishioners have asked me if I knew of anyone who needed help and how they can assist them. Well, here is your chance to step up and give so that many throughout our diocese may receive the help they need. As of the writing of this message we have reached \$122,928.07 in pledges toward our parish goal of \$130,956.46. That puts us at \$8,028.39 shy of our goal. And remember, anything that is over our goal comes back to us for our own use. 


