

ADORATION CHAPEL REOPENING

It is with great joy that we are now once again able to offer Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our Adoration Chapel. While Adoration will take place with the Eucharist reposed in the tabernacle, we hope that each person who spends time with our Lord Jesus Christ will gain strength in their faith and come to a deeper relationship with Him. Here are few things to keep in mind when coming to the Chapel as we continue to observe restrictions due to the Coronavirus Pandemic:

- 1. Because of the small space, there should be no more than four people at a time in the chapel.
- 2. Registration is required through the "We Adore Him" App
- 3. Please sign-in on the kiosk located in the hallway. (Instructions are provided)
- 4. Each visitor must answer the COVID-19 questions before each visit. If you cannot answer "no" to all of the questions, then you should not enter the chapel
- 5. Everyone should always wear appropriate face coverings while in the chapel.
- 6. No reading materials will be provided at this time. If you bring your own reading materials, please be sure to take them with you when you leave.
- 7. Do not leave literature of any kind in the chapel upon your departure
- 8. Before your departure, please use the sanitizing wipes provided to clean all surfaces that you have come into contact with. Discard these wipes in the trash receptacle when finished. Please use ONLY the wipes that are provided. Bleach based wipes will damage the wood surfaces.
- 9. For your safety, the safety of other adorers and the protection of the Eucharist, do not share the access code with others.


